Bridgewater Sinfonia grew from a passion and enthusiasm for live classical music and a desire to provide the community with something more usually found only in larger towns. Except during the extended period of Covid restrictions, the orchestra has presented an annual season of symphonic concerts right on our doorstep in Berkhamsted since its foundation in 1998, and in June 2018 celebrated its 20th anniversary. The programmes, often featuring excellent young soloists, cover a wide spectrum of styles and periods, sharing with the audience the great classics as well as less familiar and more modern works, all in the intimate atmosphere of St Peter's Church.

Drawing on the remarkable wealth of musical talent in the locality, the Sinfonia is a happy combination of professional players who live in the area, and talented semi-professional musicians who may pursue other careers in parallel. It is a registered charity which aims to bring the pleasure of classical music to the wider community, and to encourage young people to develop their interest in music.

This year, 2023, marks the orchestra's 25th anniversary, and introduces a season of celebrations.
